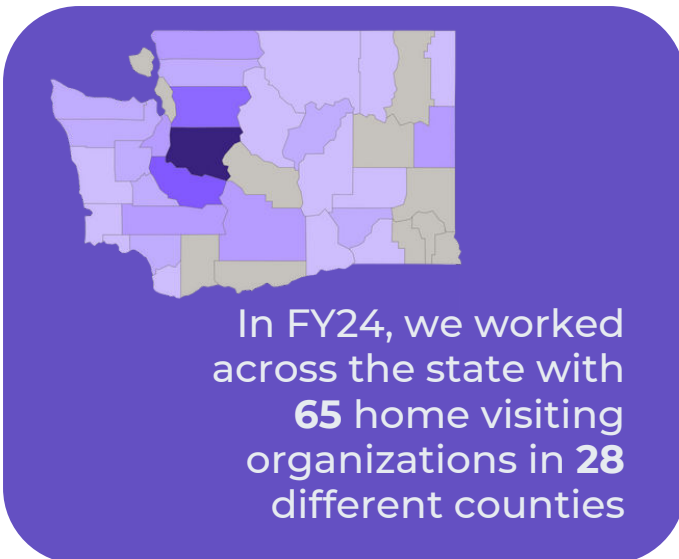


Effective professional learning which includes training, professional development and technical assistance, creates confident, competent early childhood professionals who can **better support families in achieving their goals.**

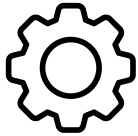

We surveyed home visiting staff + supervisors who regularly receive ongoing individualized technical assistance from us. Of those who answered...



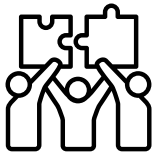
91% agreed that their skills and knowledge increased
